SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CONTEST
OFFICIAL RULES

1. Eligibility: ClassADrivers.com's Scholarship Award Contest (the "Contest") is open only to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia over the age of 18 with access to the Internet and a valid email account. You must be a student who is currently enrolled at or has been accepted to an accredited university, trucking school, trade school or vocational school at the time of entry. All employees of MH Sub I, LLC ("Sponsor"), all associated agencies and their respective affiliates, licensees or agents (collectively, "Contest Entities"), and their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses) and those living in the same household of each (whether related or not), are ineligible to participate in the Contest. All applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited or restricted by law. Entry in the Contest constitutes your full and unconditional acceptance of these Official Rules. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

2. Contest Period: Unless specified otherwise, the Contest entry period begins on January 15, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. PST and ends at 11:59 p.m. PST on May 30, 2018 (the "Contest Period"). Winners will be selected from entries properly submitted and timely received during the Contest Period.

3. Contest Entry: You may enter the Contest during the Contest Period by using an APPROVED method of entry. The APPROVED method(s) of entry is:

Online Entry. To enter, you must complete the following steps during the Contest Period:

1. Write an essay of one thousand (1,000) words or more on the topic of "Tech and Truckers: How Can Truck Drivers Take Advantage of Future Leaps in Technology? What scenarios do you see for truck drivers to remain a valuable and successful resource in the workforce of 2023? How would they prepare and what skills they would need to hone to get ready for the future challenges?"
2. You must publish your entry online publicly. This can be a student blog on your university website, your own website, or a blog platform like medium.com, blogger.com, or similar websites.
3. Include at least three links in your essay citing authoritative sources on trucking, technology, or education, including one link to www.classadvertisers.com.
4. Fill out the Entry Form on the Contest webpage to complete your entry.

All entries must be in English. Your entry must further comply with all of the following requirements:

- Your entry must not violate any right of a third party including, without limitation, any copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, confidentiality, publicity, privacy, and any other intellectual property right.
- Your entry must be your original work of authorship, sole property, previously unpublished, and not previously submitted in any other contest, sweepstakes or promotion.
- Your entry must not contain any personally identifiable information of any person other than yourself.
- Your entry must not include any content or material that depicts or incorporates unsafe behavior or situations, obscenity, defamation, disparagement of any product, person, or organization, or any other inappropriate or objectionable content or material, as determined in the sole discretion by the judges and/or Sponsor.

Entries received prior to May 1, 2018 may receive feedback or suggestions from the ClassADrivers.com team. You may make changes, additions, subtractions, or updates to the blog post portion of your entry in response to ClassADrivers.com feedback or suggestions at your own risk. You are not obligated to respond to ClassADrivers.com feedback or suggestions or alter your entry in any way. The blog post portion of the entry may be altered or updated at your sole discretion up to the end of the Contest Period. Altering the blog post portion of your entry after the end of the Contest Period is prohibited and may result in disqualification. Entries received after May 1, 2018 will not receive any feedback or suggestions.

Limit one (1) entry per person or email address. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same email account. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification. In the event of a dispute as to any registration, the authorized account holder will be deemed to be the participant. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email account. The potential winners may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.

All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. By submitting an entry, you agree that Sponsor and its affiliates and subsidiaries have the unrestricted right and non-exclusive license to use your entry in whole or in part, commercially or non-commercially, in any media known or unknown, in perpetuity, worldwide, including the right to publish, display, copy, distribute, and sublicense the entry for advertising or publicity purposes, and to edit, modify, and make derivative works thereof, all without additional review by or compensation to you. As a condition of submitting your entry, you agree that each of Sponsor and its affiliates and subsidiaries may link to or post your entry on its website(s), web pages of third-party sites, and other publications for advertising and promotional purposes without review by or compensation to

you. By submitting your information for the Sweepstakes, you consent to being contacted via phone and/or email by ClassADrivers.com for the purposes other than those related to the Sweepstakes. 4. Selection of Contest Winners/Odds: There will be one (1) winner chosen from five (5) finalists chosen from all entries submitted in the Contest. The five (5) finalists will be chosen by a panel of judges from ClassADrivers.com. Entries will be objectively scored based on the following:

- 30% based on the clear definition of what the most likely truck driving job/career scenario(s) will look like in 2023 and why. (qualitative/quantitative assessment)
- 10% based on a clear definition of the skill or list of skills (if any) that the truck drivers currently possess that will make them successful under the scenario(s) most likely to happen and why.
- 20% based on a clear definition of the skill or list of skills the truck drivers need to hone to be more successful and why.
- 40% based on the description of how the truck driver can train or prepare in the next few months/years to develop the skills necessary to stay relevant and be more successful in the job market of 2023 and why.

The five (5) entries with the best score will become finalists. After the five (5) finalists are chosen, the one (1) winner will be chosen by the ClassADriver.com community members. The members will review the finalist's entries and choose one (1) entry to be their vote for the winner. The entry that receives the most votes will be chosen as the overall winner of the Contest. In case of a tie, community members will be notified and an additional round of voting will take place between the tying entries only.

The winner will be selected on or before June 15, 2018. The winner will be notified via email and/or phone. The winner will be announced in the News section on ClassADrivers.com, in the ClassADrivers.com Newsletter, and on social media channels. In the event that a winner(s) is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, award the applicable prize(s) to an alternate winner(s). Any return of prize notification or prize email as undeliverable will result in forfeiture of any prize(s) and an alternate winner(s) may, at Sponsor's discretion, be selected. Decisions of the Sponsor on all matters relating to the Contest are final. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen, are not transferable and are not redeemable for cash. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if entire prize(s) or a portion of advertised prize(s) is unavailable for any reason. The Contest Partner will deliver the prizes to the winners by Federal Express (FedEx), United Parcel Service (UPS), or a similarly suitable shipping service. The reporting and payment of any tax liabilities (federal, state and local) incurred by the winners as a result of the Contest are the sole responsibility of the winners. Sponsor will issue an IRS Form 1099 to winner for tax reporting purposes. Any costs related to participating in the Contest and/or claiming or using a prize, are the responsibility of the winner.
